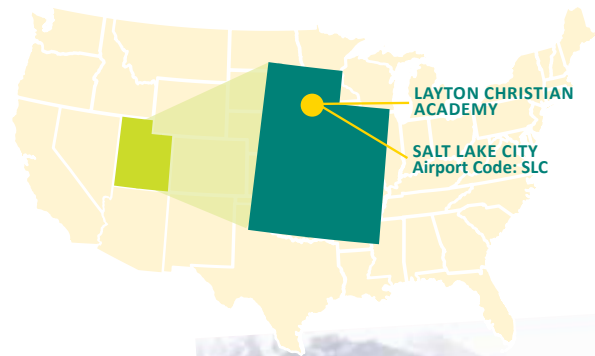

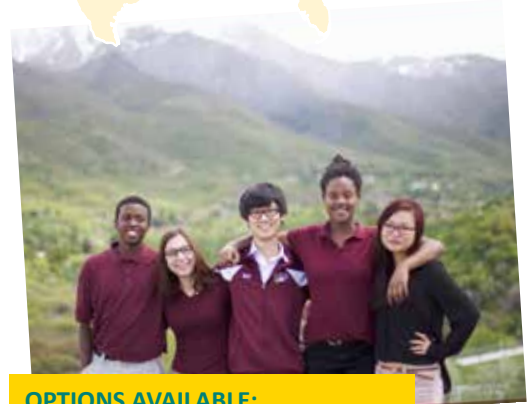
SPORTS AND ARTS
