Washington Academy offers a top tier private education located in a quaint ocean-side town. 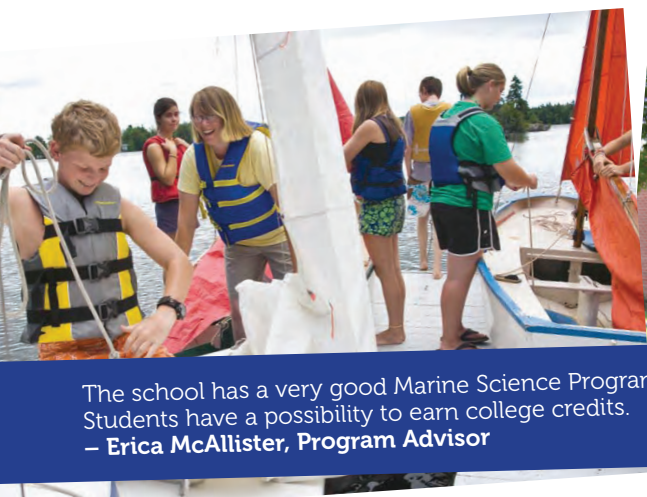
